2026 marks 250 years since the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Communities across America are asking, ***“What is Our Place in this Story?”***

For most, the answer is straightforward. For Pensacola, it is more complicated and far more interesting. Under British rule, the residents of this small Gulf port town stood 2,000 miles from the front lines of America's revolution, and yet their choices helped determine its outcome.

***Opening May 9th, 2026 at the Pensacola Museum of History,*** this exhibit tells that story through original letters, artifacts, and paintings.
