## Visitor Summary – April 2022



#### **April 2022 Visitor Summary**

- » Data should be interpreted with caution as monthly sample sizes are modest resulting in larger month-to-month variation.
- » Number of visitors for April increased +5.0% compared to last year.
  - » Compared to April 2021, travel party sizes were larger and there were more units available, resulting in an increase in the number of visitors despite lower occupancy rates.
- » Airline passengers increased +16.3% compared to April of last year.
- » Hotel occupancy was down -6.1% from last year and ADR was up +11.5%, resulting in a RevPAR that was up +4.7% from last year.
- » Hotel room nights were down -0.3% compared to April 2021.
- Visitors were more likely to have visited the area just for the day.

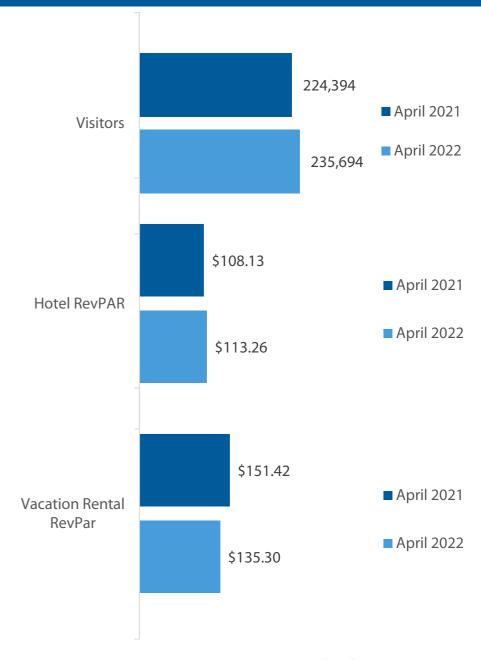

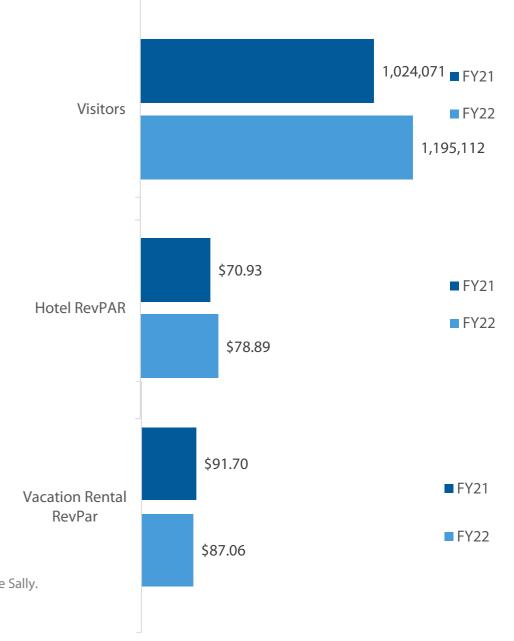

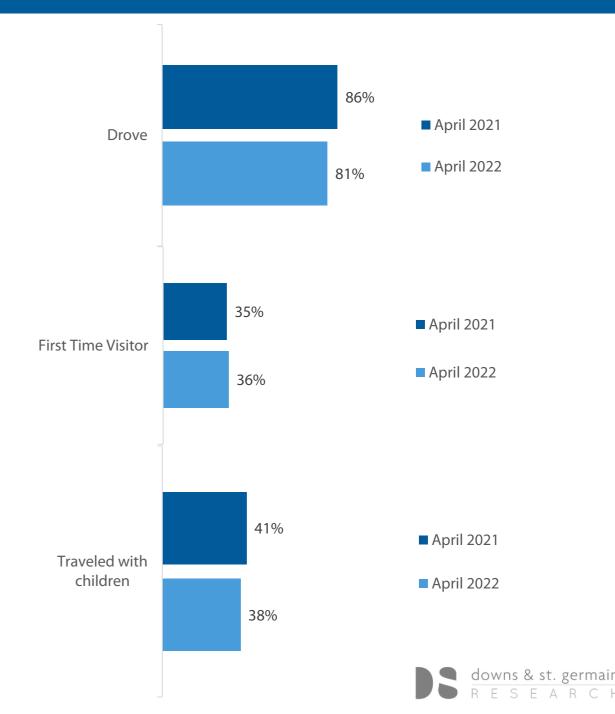
